- Mr. Douglas M. Brown, principal in Brown and Brown Ventures, L.L.C., a real estate holding and Internet company.
- Dr. James C. Wetherbe, associate dean, Robert Stevenson Chaired Professor of Information Technology and director of the Institute of Internet Buyer Behavior at the Rawls College of Business at Texas Tech University.

The candidates spent the lunch hour with students in the Jackson Center answering questions and hearing about their concerns. They also spent significant time meeting with the Provost's Cabinet, faculty members and staff during the interview process.
