BUILD YOUR RESUME - GET CERTIFIED IN SPANISH THROUGH THE INSTITUTO CERVANTES. Through a federal grant, the Anderson School will subsidize 50% of the cost for students to obtain certification in Spanish through the Instituto Cervantes.

This program is affiliated with the government of Spain and provides an internationally recognized credential that can be used as a credential to certify Spanish fluency (beginning, intermediate or advanced).

Staff from the Instituto Cervantes will be available 11:45-12:30 on Tuesday, MAR 31, in GSM 302 to discuss the certification process and to answer any questions.
