Anderson EMBA students had a unique opportunity to study the intersection of business and the American public policy process. Sessions focused on the policy-making role of the Executive Branch, law-making and oversight functions of the Legislative Branch, the regulatory process, and the formation of economic policy. Participants also studied the roles of lobbyists and special interest groups. Guest lecturers included top government officials, such as, Martin Heinrich and Ms. Angela Buchanan. While there, students visited the Ronald Reagan Building, United States Chamber of Commerce, The White House, and the United States Capitol, where policy decisions are deliberated.
